ADDITIONAL STUDY PROGRAMME - 2017

Dear Parents,

I would like to take the opportunity to outline our additional study programme for students in Yrs 10, 11, 12 & 13. The following pages of this booklet contain details of the timetable, which outlines dates and times for the subject sessions.

It is important that your daughter takes careful note of the attached timetable and picks up the specific subject lessons on it. The timetable contains the subject information, including the name of the teacher who will be delivering the additional study session for that subject (please note that in some instances it may not always be your daughter's usual teacher). There is also subject content information as well as rooming details.

Students who wish to attend are not required to wear Academy uniform for any of the sessions advertised. They should, of course, come dressed and equipped in an appropriate manner for study. Students must enter and leave via the main reception and should be registered in class by their subject teachers as well as signing in upon arrival. In the unlikely event of a fire alarm, staff and students should evacuate the premises as normal and line up on Princes Park to be registered.

No refreshments will be available on-site during the additional study dates and students are asked to bring their own refreshments on the dates that they attend. Students will also have the option of going off-site for their lunch (at their own risk) during the half hour lunch sessions over the three days of the May half term if they have your agreement in advance. Students who choose to do so must inform their teachers of this prior to leaving the premises and sign back in with their teacher at the start of the next session.

Students will be reminded in advance by their subject teachers of the study sessions as they occur and we will endeavour to send out text reminders to you to keep you informed.

Attendance at the additional sessions is voluntary but we would emphasise the importance of your daughter attending the programme in order to benefit her overall learning. In relation to this, there is considerable evidence to suggest that students who attended the additional study sessions last year went on to perform exceptionally well in their external exams.

We would ask you as parents to support us by helping to encourage your daughter to take up the opportunities on offer to her both during enrichment and via the additional study programme. We all appreciate that this is a potentially stressful time for your daughter and we are certain that these sessions will only serve to boost confidence, enhance performance and help to diminish anxiety.
