All our students benefit from a diversity of exciting educational opportunities in an exceptional setting which combines five Victorian villas and their gardens with a purpose built new extension which contains state-of-the-art facilities in several curriculum areas including performing arts, modern foreign languages and science.

In **2010**, Ofsted judged The Belvedere Academy to be **"outstanding"** saying that **"the core values of Belvedere have been maintained in**
