



Year 10/11 Exam Revision Sessions

The following pages outline details for our Year 11 students of the exam preparations and study arrangements for the final few weeks of the year. There are also some additional sessions for Y10 students, some of whom will be sitting GCSEs this year.

Starting from Monday 5th June 2017 the normal Year 11 teaching timetable will cease to operate due to the frequency of examinations taking place that week and beyond. Instead of this, Year 11 students are expected to attend the revision sessions outlined, sit an exam or undertake private study at home or in the library.

There will also be some special arrangements made during the three week period prior to the May Half Term for students studying the subjects indicated below. Special revision sessions will run for these subjects instead of normal lessons on certain dates. The normal teaching timetable will still operate during this initial period and students must attend school as normal for lessons and in some cases their first GCSE exams.

The revision sessions have been timetabled to occur either the afternoon before an exam the following day or during the morning before an afternoon exam. The intention is that the revision sessions provide our students with a last boost of essential knowledge and an opportunity to refresh information that will hopefully be pertinent to the GCSE exam questions.

The majority of revision sessions will be delivered over a 2 hour period either 10.00am – 12.15pm or 1.15pm – 3.15pm. The sessions will be delivered by the normal Year 11 subject teacher where possible. Attendance at all of the relevant revision sessions by Year 11 students is highly recommended as a means of them reinforcing prior knowledge and learning. Please note that there will be some clashes between exams and some revision sessions, this is unavoidable.

Year 10/11 students should attend the revision sessions outlined on the next few pages (as appropriate) and attend all of their GCSE exams up until the completion of their final exam (see the separate 2017 Exam Timetable document, which is available on the Academy website). Where there are no timetabled revision sessions, Y11 students should take the opportunity to conduct their own private study either at home or in the library. Students using the library for private study must sign in and out at the Pastoral Office for health and safety purposes.

Finally, although not officially the end of Year 11 due to the ongoing revision sessions and external exams, we will be arranging a finishing of Year 11 celebration mid-morning assembly, followed by a buffet lunch for our students and teachers on Friday 26th May. Mrs Mansfield, Head of Upper School, will make details of this available nearer to the time.
